In the past several questions have arisen on who should get acting pay in certain special cases; I submit the following for your approval:

A Lt. assigned to an aerial or quint will receive acting pay.

A Lt. assigned to Station 3 will receive acting pay.

A Lt. assigned to Stations 11 or 12 will not receive acting pay unless they are assigned as Acting Station Commander, by the Chief of Firefighting.

A Lt. assigned to Fire Central will not receive acting pay unless he/she is assigned the duties of the Captain, by the Chief of Management Services.

A Lt. in a double Company Station will not receive acting pay when the aerial is placed out of service.
