Dress Policy

POLICY: IT IS THE POLICY OF THE MIAMI DEPARTMENT OF FIRE RESCUE TO ALLOW FLEXIBILITY IN UNIFORM WEAR FOR COMMUNICATIONS OPERATORS DURING WEEKEND AND HOLIDAY HOURS.

THE POLICY OUTLINED BELOW WAS DEVELOPED THROUGH THE LABOR/MANAGEMENT PROCESS FOR THE WEEKEND AND HOLIDAY DRESS OF COMMUNICATIONS OPERATORS.

PROCEDURE: ON WEEKENDS AND HOLIDAYS, COMMUNICATIONS OPERATORS WILL BE ALLOWED TO WEAR CIVILIAN DRESS WITHIN THE GENERAL GUIDELINES OF GOOD TASTE AS DETERMINED BY THE ON DUTY COMMUNICATIONS SUPERVISOR.

THE FOLLOWING IS UNDESIRABLE ATTIRE:

TANK, HALTER OR CROP TOPS
SEE-THROUGH BLOUSES
JOGGING, BIKING, SHORTS (THE EXCEPTION WILL BE DRESS BERMUDA SHORTS).
SANDALS OR FLIP-FLOPS
ROLLERS (HAIR)
WORN, TORN OR FADED JEANS

ENFORCEMENT: ANYONE REPORTING IN UNDESIRABLE ATTIRE WILL BE SENT HOME ON "V" OR "E" TO CHANGE FOR A MAXIMUM OF TWO HOURS. OPERATORS FAILING TO RETURN WITHIN TWO HOURS WILL BE CONSIDERED AWOL AND DISCIPLINED ACCORDINGLY.
